



# **Operations and Standards Committee Bulletin**

## **Purpose of Bulletin**

The purpose of this bulletin is to reinforce the secondary end-dating standard and the standards regarding movement of students reviewed by the Operations and Standards Committee, and approved by the Service Management Council.

This bulletin reinforces previously published information about processes that are not being followed. Please distribute to your users.

### **End Dating Secondary School Associations**

Audience: Clerical staff who look after student membership records.

**Secondary School Associations** are created by secondary schools and they are end-dated by the school that created them. Primary schools should not be end-dating secondary school associations that belong to other schools. If a primary school believes a secondary school association should be end-dated, please contact the secondary school and ask them to do so. It is their data.

If you end a secondary school association that does not belong to you, you interfere with student courses, marks and other data related to that course. In particular, DL schools are reporting that schools are ending their secondary school associations with no communication. Student information is lost and DL funding may be affected.

#### **Student Movement Between Districts**

Audience: Clerical staff who withdraw, register and transfer students.

**Within a district** schools can use the transfer function to move students between schools. Designations and IEP's stay intact.

**Between districts** schools must withdraw the student and the new school must register them – do not use the transfer function between districts. This ends the IEP and Designation. This also allows the receiving district to enter correct registration information in the membership record.
