


Graduation Reports

2018 Graduation Program Reports


- 2018 Graduation Program Reports display six new graduation requirements:

New Requirement Codes Display

- These requirements display on reports in a familiar way using alpha (DVR) or numeric (School Transcript Report) codes
 - AST (11) Arts Educ/Applied Design, Skills and Technologies
 - CLC (13) Career Life Education
 - CLE (12) Career Life Connections
 - PHO (10) Physical and Health Education 10
- These requirements display in a new area
 - NMA (16) Numeracy Assessment
 - *LTE Literacy Assessment *future

DVR – AST, CLC, CLE, PHO

Requirement boxes are checked for courses successfully completed (passing final mark and completion date), or currently in progress. The alphabetical diploma code displays in the Diploma Category column.



DVR – Graduation Assessments

Graduation Assessments box displays when the student has written an assessment or a transitional equivalent course. All graduation assessment records display on the DVR.



2018 Graduation Program Requirements

Minimum 80 credits over Grade 10-12, including successful completion of the courses listed below. Students may have earned more than 80 credits but not have successfully completed all required courses. All Ministry-Authorized, Board/Authority-Authorized, or post-secondary courses count toward graduation.

- The graduation requirements below are designated by a code number (e.g. 1-13) in the REQ column:
 - 1 = Language Arts 10 (4 credits)*
 - 2 = Language Arts 11 (4 credits)
 - 3 = Language Arts 12 (4 credits)
 - t = Social Studies 10 (4 credits)
 - 5 = Social Studies 11 or 12 (4 credits)
 - 6 = Mathematics 10 (4 credits)
 - 7 = Mathematics 11 or 12 (4 credits)
 - 8 = Science 10 (4 credits)
 - 9 = Science 11 or 12 (4 credits)
 - 10 = Physical and Health Education 10 (4 credits)
 - 11 = Arts Education and/or Applied Design, Skills and Technology 10, 11 or 12 (4 credits)
 - 12 = Career Life Education (4 credits)
 - 13 = Career Life Connections (4 credits)
 - * If more than one course is designated as meeting requirement 1, then 2 credits from each course are being counted toward the requirement.
- In addition to the above 13 requirements, students need 28 credits for Elective Courses (00). Minimum of 16 of 80 credits, including Language Arts 12, must be at the Grade 12 level. Plus, students must meet the Literacy Graduation Assessment requirement (15) and the Numeracy Graduation Assessment requirement (16).

All Grade 10 and 11 courses are reported as Final % only, even for courses where an exam may have been written.
