New Features and Enhancements in MyEducation BC

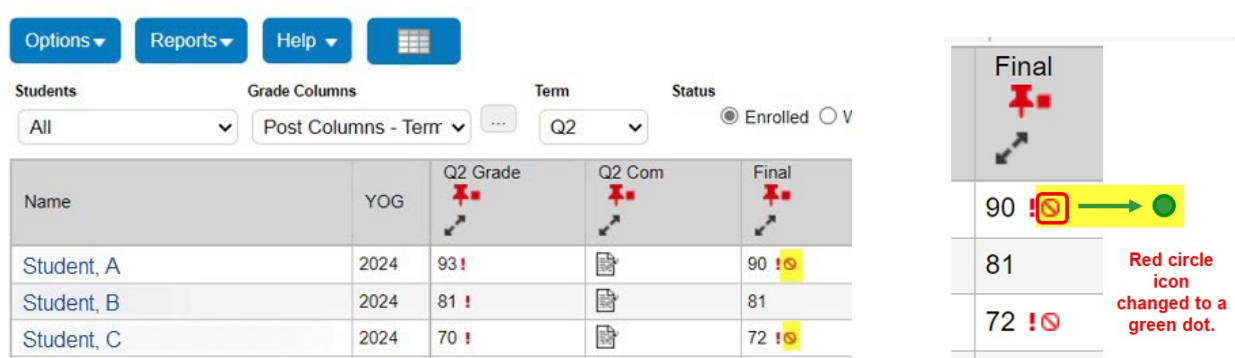
The following new features and enhancements have been implemented in MyEducation BC:

Grade Entry – Red circle with line through it has been replaced with green dot

The “red circle with a line through it” symbol showing marks that have been manually entered has been removed from the gradebook and replaced with a green dot.

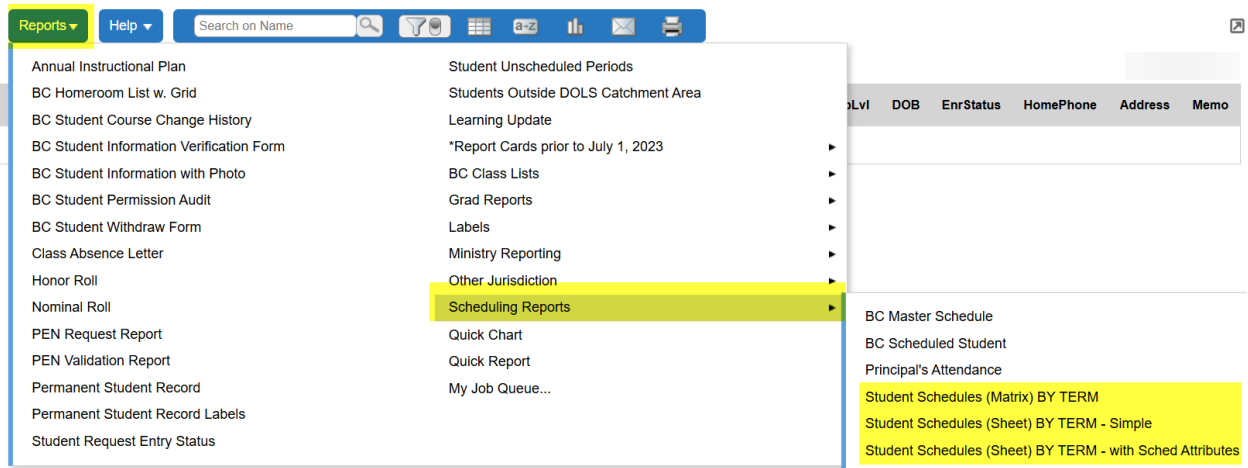

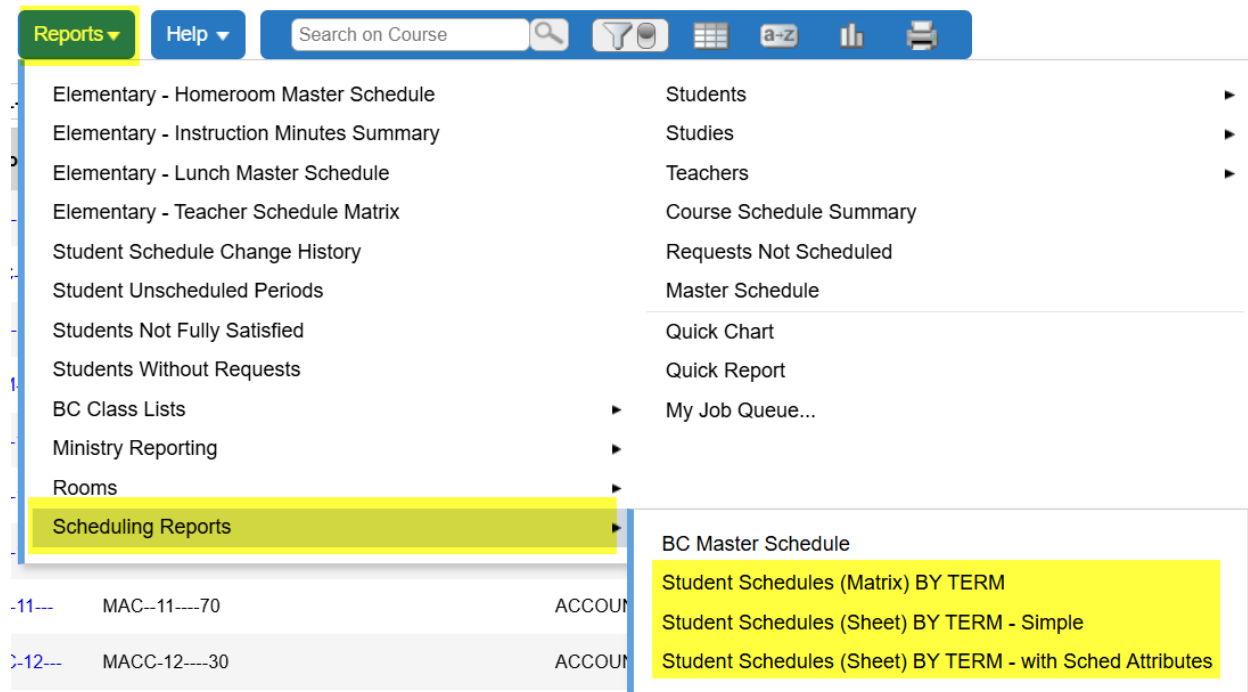

Graduation Status Report – Show “X” of “Y” Credits

An enhancement has been made to the credits label for each of the learning areas in the Graduation Status Report. Labels now show “X” of “Y” credits (ex. 4 of 4 credits), allowing users to determine whether the student has earned the correct number of credits to meet the requirement.

Navigation: School View > Student top tab > Transcript side tab > Reports > Grad Reports > Graduation Status Update

Note: “Completed Requirements” and “Requirements currently enrolled or in progress” learning area labels will be the same value, ex. *Social Studies 10 (4 of 4 credits)*, whereas “Requirements yet to complete” will be different values, ex. *Mathematics 10 (0 of 4 credits)*.
