
## **New Features and Enhancements in MyEducation BC**

The following new features and enhancements have been implemented in MyEducation BC:





### **Show all alerts in Teacher Gradebook**

Staff View > Gradebook top tab > Course section > Scores side tab

The Scores side tab of a course section will display all alerts pertaining to a student when the “Show student alerts” preference is selected in the gradebook settings:

### **Student Alternate Email**

With this enhancement, the Student top tab > Details side tab now includes a field to enter an ‘Alternate Email’ in a student’s record so both a district and personal email address can be recorded.

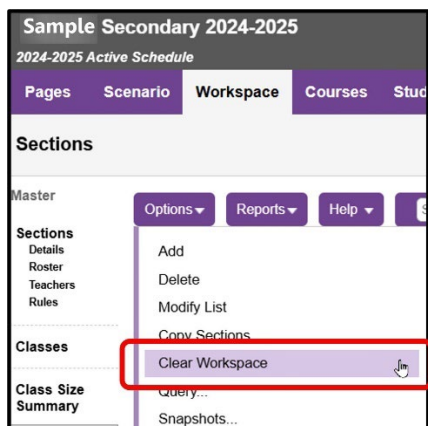

## Build View – ‘Clear Workspace’ option has been removed

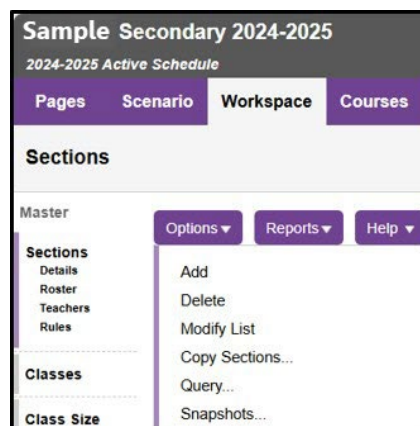
Build View scenario > Workspace top tab

The option to ‘Clear Workspace’ in a Build View scenario > Workspace top tab has been removed. This enhancement eliminates a user’s ability to permanently delete all scheduled sections and all student schedules by mistake. You will now need to manually delete course sections in the Workspace top tab in Build View.

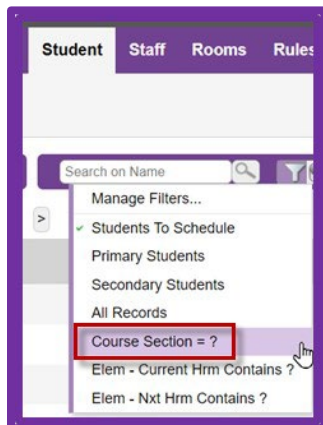
