



## **New Features and Enhancements in MyEducation BC**

The following new features and enhancements have been implemented in MyEducation BC:


### New Login Screen with Preferred Language Selection

A new login screen has been introduced where users can set their preferred language on the login pop-up.



The ability to login with the BC Service Card application is still available for students. Click the button to "Log in with Another Provider", then select "BC Services Card app":

Reset your password if you have forgotten your password.


If the link to "Retrieve your Login ID" is selected, you will be prompted to provide an email address. Enter your district e-mail address in the field provided, the click the "Recover Login ID" button:



If the link to "Reset your password" is selected, you will be prompted to provide your Login ID. Enter your Login ID in the field provided, then click the "Recover Password" button:



A new "password has expired" screen has been introduced. Click on the blue link for "Requirements" to see the list of complexity requirements for a new password, if required:



As always, if further assistance is required, student password resets are managed at the school level, while staff password resets are managed at the Help Desk level.


### Gender Identity Field Added to the BC Marks Verification With Comments Report

Staff View > Gradebook top tab > Reports

A gender identity field has been added to the **BC Marks Verification with Comments** report. If a student has a gender identity entered in their student demographics tab, this will appear on the report.




**Note:** If the Gender Identity field is not populated {null}, then the data will be pulled from the Gender field.




#### TRAX Student Withdrawals and Terminated Status

A note has been added to the bottom of the student withdrawal wizard to remind users "Prior to withdrawing a student, ensure you have submitted CRS, DEM, and XAM files for grade 10, 11, or 12 courses with withdrawals or final marks to the Ministry and confirming the accuracy of their Ministry Transcript."



#### New Diploma Verification Report (DVR) and Graduation Status Update (GSU) Visual Indicator

A new visual indicator has been added to the DVR and GSU for use when the requirement is partially met - courses(s) or assessment(s) - scheduled or in progress. This indicator will display as follows:




### Print Double Sided Option Added to the Diploma Verification Report (DVR)

This enhancement gives users the option to print double sided when printing DVRs. When choosing this option to print DVRs in batches, an additional blank page is added to odd numbered page reports, so a blank page is printed at the end of the report, thus ensuring the next student's first page appears on a new page.




### **Set Default Assignment Category**

Teachers are now able to set a default assignment category for each class section. Once "Default category for assignments" is enabled, MyEducation BC will automatically assign that category to each new assignment for the class. Teachers can still manually edit an assignment, if needed.




#### Additional Colors for Special Codes

Teachers now have a more vibrant assortment of colors to choose from in the Special Codes using the color gradations strip. The code appears in the selected color when it is entered on the Scores page.



### Special Code for Missing Assignments

Teachers can now create a special code that is worth a percentage of an assignment's total points to prevent students from receiving zero points for missing assignments. This will help minimize the impact missed assignments have on a student's average grade:



#### **Expanded Teacher Classes Widget**

The "Classes Meeting" and "Classes Not Meeting" columns in the Teacher Classes widget have been expanded, thus eliminating the truncation of class names that are too long to display:
